Free Online STEM Program for High School Sophomores with 2.7 GPA or Higher

The Virginia Space Coast Scholars (VSCS) program is for high school sophomores interested in science, engineering, and technology related to current NASA missions by NASA Wallops Flight Facility.

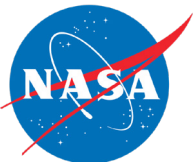
The program features two key elements. The first is an on-line science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) learning experience featuring five modules.

Upon completion of the on-line program, a competitive selection process will identify top performing scholars who will be invited to attend a seven-day residential

Summer Academy at NASA Wallops Flight Facility on Wallops Island, VA. Students must be a U.S. Citizen to attend the Summer Academy.

During the week-long FREE summer academy, scholars will learn firsthand from NASA professionals and their partners about the latest, cutting-edge technologies and missions.
